RULES

A theatrical production incorporates the efforts of a group of people each trying to do their best for themselves and the audience. In order for each person to do his/her best each of us must remember to follow a few simple rules. A brief orientation will be given to review the rules and what is expected of the participants.

For the safety and enjoyment of all: Continued disruption of the rules, hitting, harassing or profanity may result in immediate expulsion from the program. No refunds will be given.

MONITORING

To keep tuition at a minimum, our workshop is an all-volunteer program and parent participation is greatly appreciated and needed. This program is designed to teach children and allow them to experience the art of live theater. Volunteers are here to facilitate the program, not to act as babysitters. While we do our best to keep a watchful eye on the participants, our focus is on implementing the program. It is the responsibility of the parents to monitor their child's behavior when they are not on stage. We have found in the past, that many parents of younger children will "take turns" being responsible for a small group. This has proved helpful, especially for those parents with evening work schedules or other smaller children at home. During final dress rehearsals and performances, several parents will be needed to help keep order backstage. Please note, dads are needed also to monitor the boys' dressing room. We will have a sign-up sheet, so parents can rotate. Hopefully all parents will be able to take a show "off" to watch their star shine on stage!

SNACKS

Each evening, we take a snack break. We ask parents to donate drinks and snacks for this and to sign up to serve the snacks. Snack examples are a cup of fruit or veggies, diced cheese, or a fruit bar with small sweet like a cookie and a small water or juice.

Please, please, please bring plenty of water. We do not have a water fountain and the kiddos get really thirsty from all their hard work! Many parents will bring a couple of cases, these can be found on sale for under \$3.00! We all know that not everyone is able to bring snacks and water, so if those of us that are able can bring a little extra, as a community, we will ensure all our little actors have enough!

During final dress rehearsals & show dates, we will need plenty of water and non-messy snacks backstage.

COSTS

As you already know, there is a tuition fee for the workshop and you may have costs associated with snacks and water. Additional costs that you may incur could include costumes. The theater may provide costumes, materials and/or reimbursement when necessary. If you have any difficulty obtaining any needed costuming or supplies for financial reasons, you may confidentially speak with the YPTW chair and help will be provided.

The final cost for the program is the cost of tickets/concessions. All tickets to all performances are \$5.00. This ticket fee applies to all audience members (backstage workers excluded). Concessions are sold during performances for \$1.00 each. These concessions are not free to anyone! Volunteers and actors should have snacks backstage.

Everyone can have a safe and fun time if we all work together.

Liability Waiver and Release Agreement

As participant in **The Young People's Theater Workshop** sponsored by **Orange Community Players, Inc.**, I am fully aware of the risks and hazards connected with my/my child's participation in **The Young People's Theater Workshop**, and hereby elect to voluntarily participate in the Activity, knowing that the Activity may be hazardous to me, my child or my property. I VOLUNTARILY ASSUME ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY RISKS OF LOSS, PROPERTY DAMAGE, OR PERSONAL INJURY, that may be sustained by me, my child, or any loss or damage to property owned by me, as a result of being engaged in the Activity, WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE ORGANIZATION OR ITS VOLUNTEERS, AGENTS, or otherwise.

I hereby RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE the Organization and their officers, servants, agents, employees, or volunteers (hereinafter "RELEASEES") from any and all liability, claims, demands, actions, and causes of action whatsoever arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury, that may be sustained by me, my child, or to any property belonging to me, WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES or otherwise, while participating in the Activity. It is my express intent that this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement (hereinafter "Agreement") shall bind the members of my family, if I am alive, and my heirs, assigns and personal representatives, if I am deceased, and shall be deemed as a RELEASE, WAIVER, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE the above-named RELEASEES. I hereby further agree that this Agreement shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas.

I hereby acknowledge that I am allowed to monitor my child at all times during their involvement with this activity and by leaving my child unattended, I do so with the knowledge that I am solely responsible for my child's welfare.
